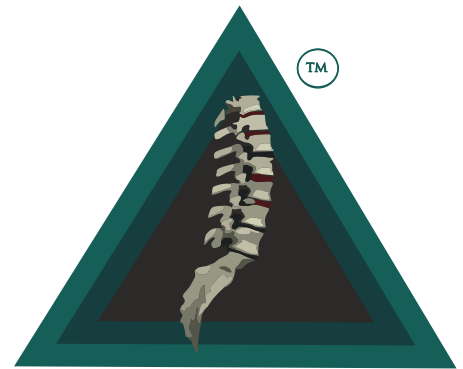


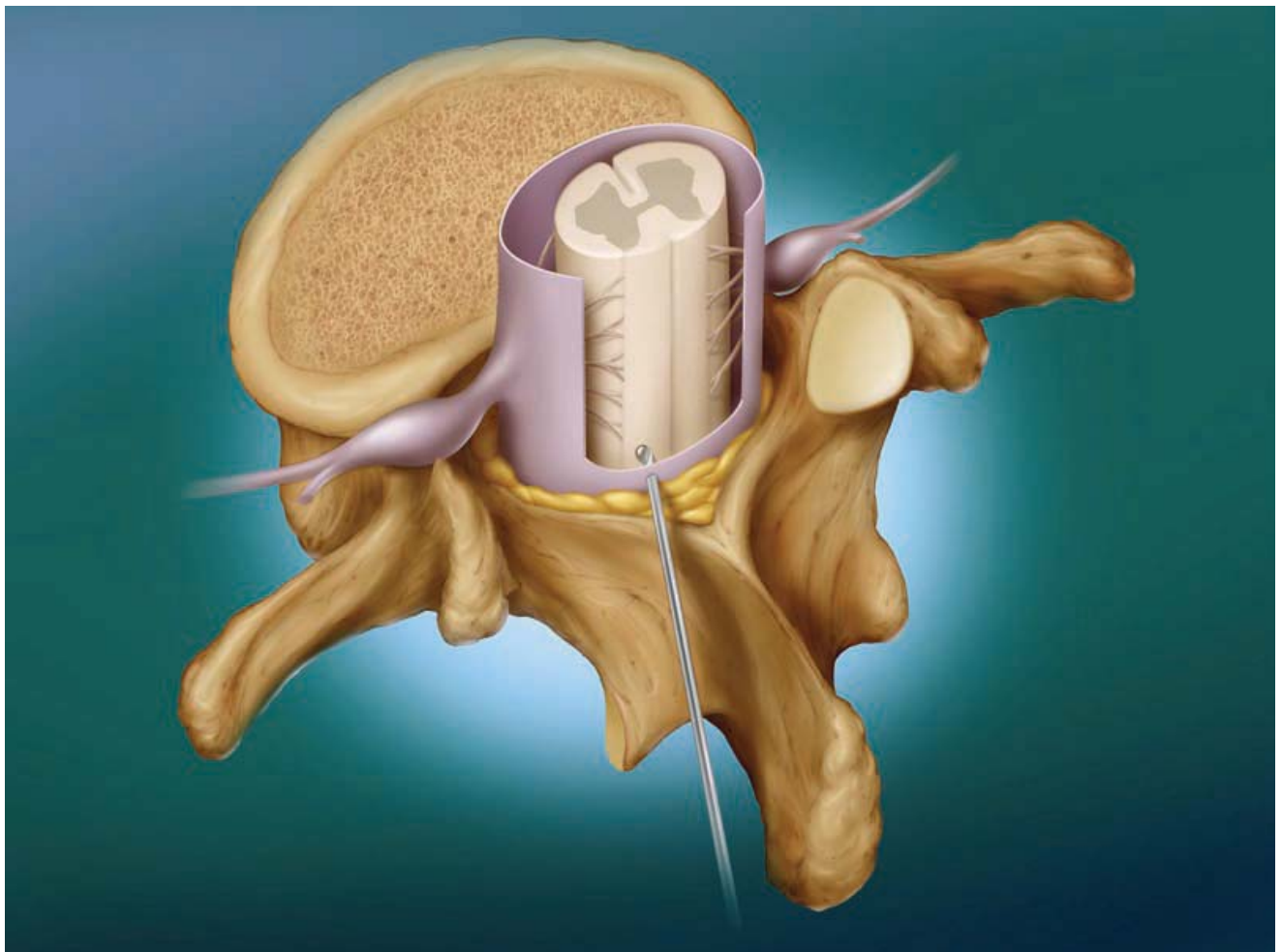

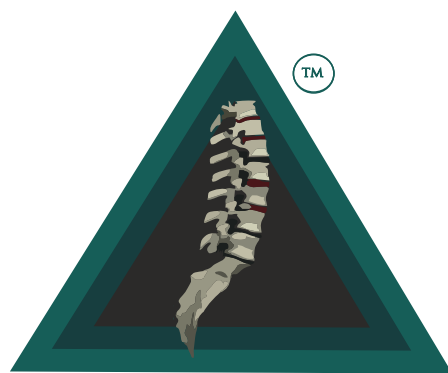
About Indian Orthopaedic Research Group

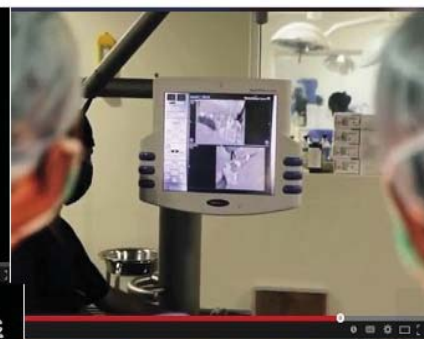
